What is a Millage Rate?

The millage rate is the amount of tax dollars levied for every \$1,000 of a property's assessed value.

\$100,000

Market Value

\$40,000

Assessed Value (40% of Market Value)

15.040 mills

Current Millage Rate

\$601.60

Annual School Property Tax



FY24 CCPS Budget Challenges

Largest New Expenses Causing FY24 Budget Challenges:



\$2.75 Million

Increase in State-Mandated Healthcare Costs/Employee Costs



\$2.9 Million

Decrease in state Equalization funding



\$2.2 Million

Increase in state required Local Fair Share cost



20% + Inflation

Increase in Operating Expenses (custodial supplies, diesel fuel, maintenance, utilities, etc.)

TOTAL = \$12 Million Deficit

*In FY23, CCPS used 6 million of reserves to offset costs to taxpayers. This is not sustainable long-term.

How Would a Rate Change Affect My Taxes?

Property Tax Estimate



Keep Same Millage Rate

40% of Market Value / 1000 x 15.04 millage rate



1 Mill Increase

40% of Market Value / 1000 x 16.04 millage rate

Catoosa Min. Livable Wage (2 Adults / 2 Children) = \$22.34 / hour



Current Classified Staff Wages

Employees with 17+ Years Experience: Custodian = \$15.15/hr Paraprofessional = \$15.43/hr Child Nutrition = \$12.73/hr
